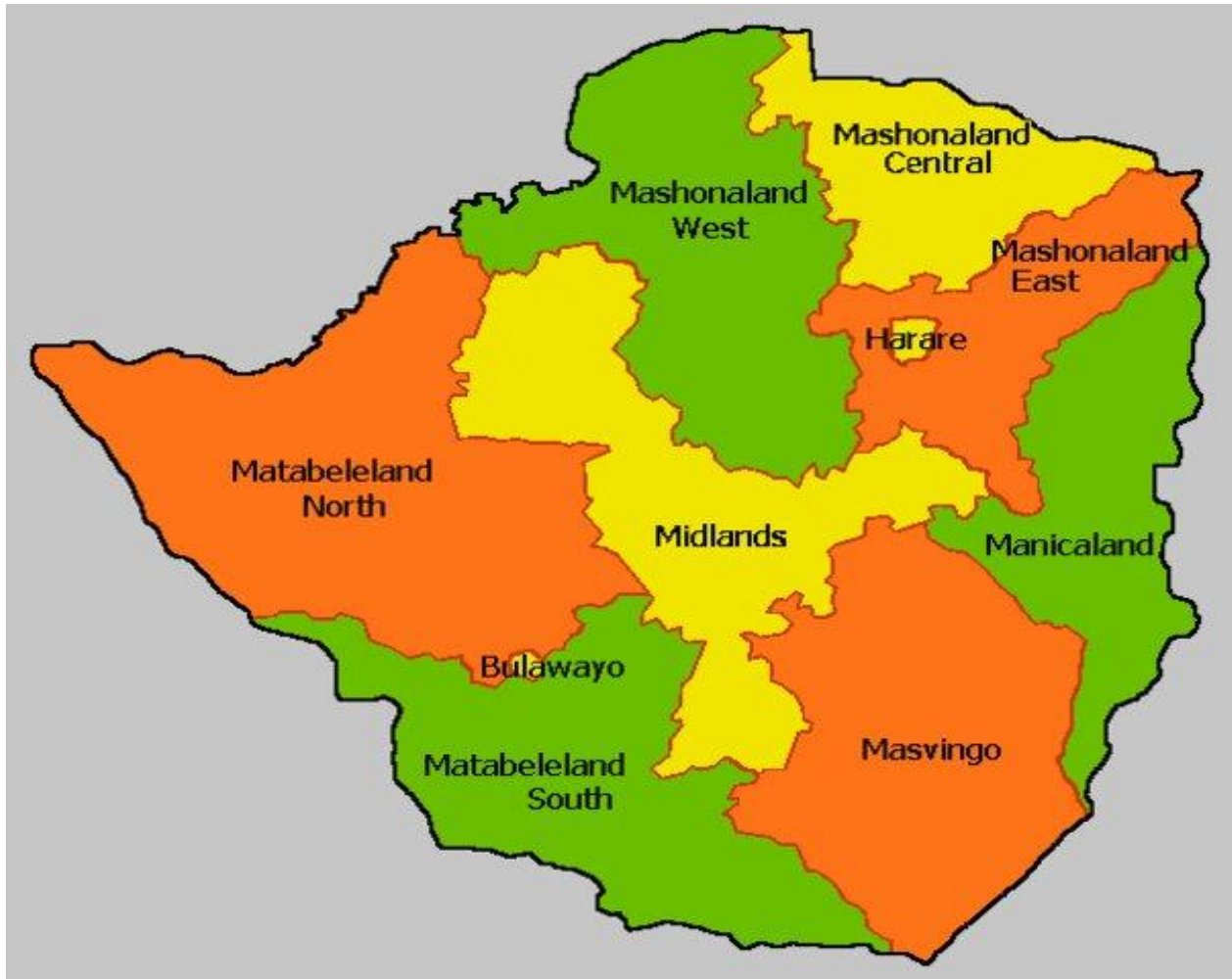

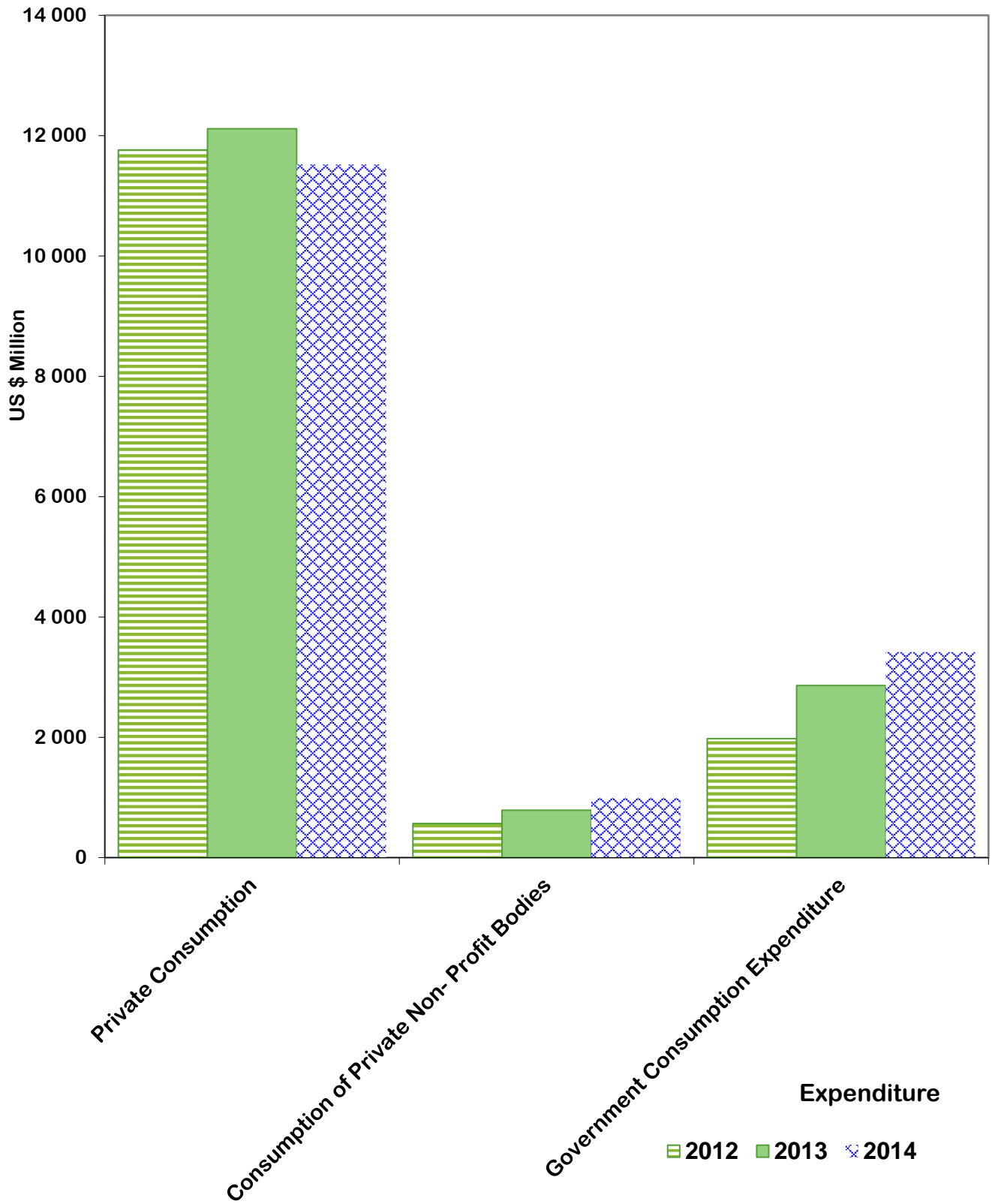

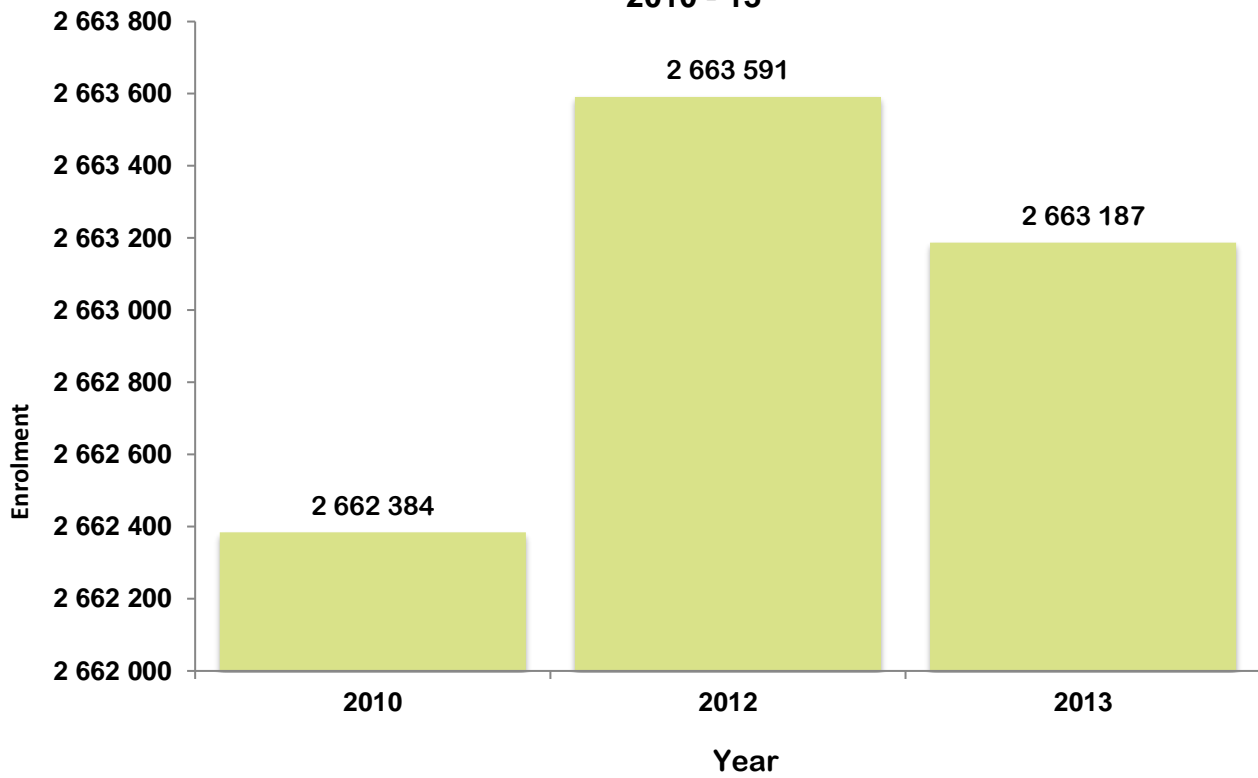

Number of Secondary Schools 2009-2013

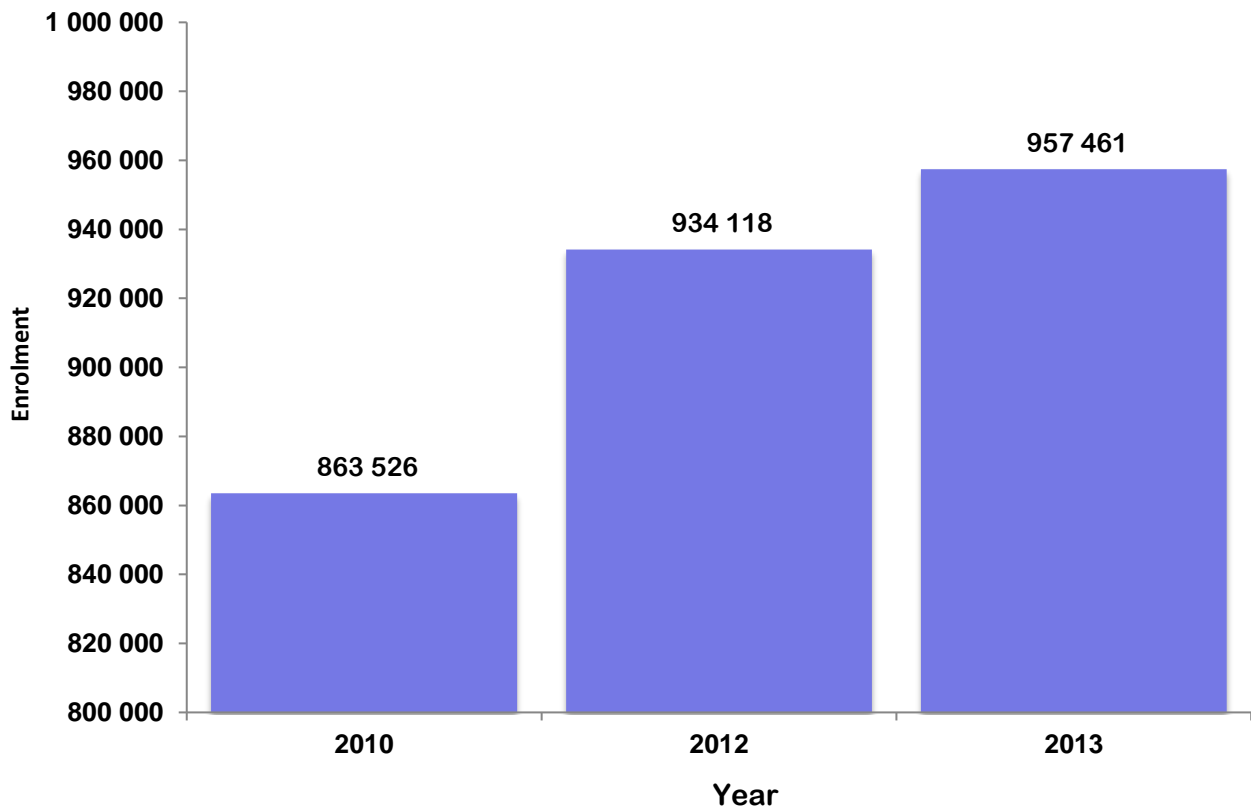

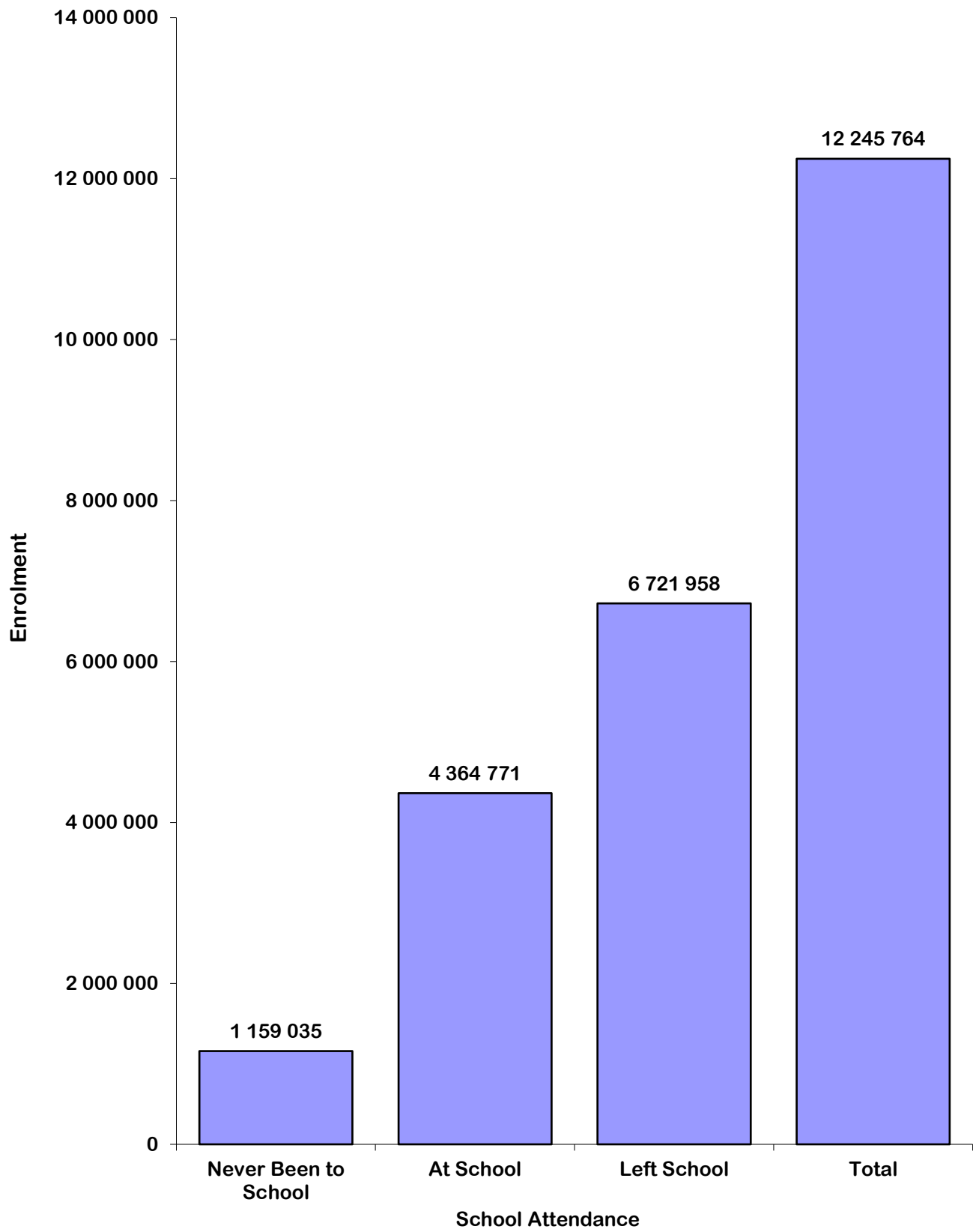
